PLUSPORTALS ACTIVATION AND RE-REGISTRATION

2017-2018: It is critically important that all parents activate their PlusPortals account. PlusPortals gives you access to your son's official report card, transcripts, and other important information. In addition, you will need your PlusPortals login to re-register your son for next school year. Re-registration will take place January 10th through the 25th. Detailed information about the re-registration process will be sent by email to all families in early January.

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: Please mark your calendar now to attend parent-teacher conferences on Tuesday, January 3 from 7:15- 9:15 a.m. Teachers will be available during this time to discuss your son's first

semester grades or other concerns. There is no school for students on January 3. The remainder of the day is designated as professional development for teachers.

You do not need to make an appointment for teacher conferences on January 3 but waiting may be necessary if other parents are in line. So that as many parents can speak with teachers as possible, please limit your conferences to 5-7 minutes per teacher.

ACT PREPARATION CLASS: Our next ACT Preparation Class will be offered on Saturday, January 28, and Saturday, February 4. If interested, your son may choose one of these two dates to attend the class. PSAT PREPARATION CLASSES: We have set the dates for the PSAT/NMSQT Preparation Course for members of the Class of 2019. These six workshops will be offered on the following dates: March 18, April 29, May 13, August 12, September 17, and October 8. The cost of the PSAT/NMSQT course is \$185. A deposit of \$100 is required when ordering a class ring.

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK: January 29 – February 4 is designated nationwide as “Catholic Schools Week.” The theme this year is “Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge, and Service.” In honor of Catholic Schools Week, many activities take place both nationally and locally. On January 30, the Diocese of Baton Rouge will host a dinner honoring its distinguished graduates from all Catholic schools in the Diocese. Catholic High will recognize Maurice Coleman ‘82 as our distinguished graduate on this occasion. We are proud to celebrate Maurice’s contributions to Catholic High and the local community. Please take some time this month to remember in your prayers Catholic High and all Catholic schools across the country who work so hard to educate the young people entrusted to our care.

SECOND SEMESTER SPECIAL SCHEDULES: On January 12 and 19, February 2 and 16, and March 9 and 15, we will be on a special schedule to incorporate grade level activities into the school day. The schedule allows for a one-hour morning session that will concentrate on the activities shown below:

- All students in grades 9-11 will attend special classes focused on standardized test preparation. Over the six sessions, students will receive concentrated instruction in reading, math, science, and English, along with taking practice standardized tests. Facilitated by our own teachers, these sessions are designed to help students improve both their comfort level and performance on standardized tests.
- 12th grade students will hear presentations during the six sessions. Topics will include substance abuse, the call to service, graduation reminders, sexual consent, the first-year college experience, and finishing high school strong.
- 8th grade students will also hear age-appropriate presentations on harassment and bullying, study skills, technology safety, substance abuse, and participate in standardized test practice.

The schedule for these six days is shown below. So that all students can participate in these important sessions, please avoid scheduling appointments during the activity time. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.

RE-REGISTRATION PROCEDURE AND FEE [From Gene Tullier]:

The timely completion of the re-registration process is critical to our effective planning for the 2017-2018 school year.

The re-registration process allows us to accurately plan the number of sections of each course needed, hire the appropriate number of qualified teachers for these courses, order and acquire adequate instructional materials, build a school master schedule and individually schedule students in a manner that accommodates as many of their needs and requests as possible. Each of these things must be done accurately and in sequence in order for us to have an organized start of the school year in August.

Because of the intricacies of planning for the coming school year, I ask for your cooperation in completing the re-registration process accurately and in a timely manner.

The Catholic High School Board of Directors has set the re-registration fee for 2017-2018 at \$450 which is the same as last year. If you are enrolled in the 12 month or the semi-annual tuition payment plan, payment of this fee is already included in your scheduled tuition payments for the current year. If you pay tuition in a single annual payment and did not already pay the re-registration fee for 2017-2018, that fee is due by January 27, 2017.

Re-registration for all students takes place online. All families will receive an email during the second week of January to notify you that re-registration is open, along with instructions. At that time, a document will be placed in the E-Locker section of your PlusPortals account with your access to the online form. Once you review the online form, please make any corrections necessary and submit the online form **no later** than January 27, 2017.

You will need access to your PlusPortals account to complete the re-registration process. If you have any questions or need help accessing PlusPortals please email jbutcher@catholichigh.org.

In addition to a re-registration fee, parents of current 8th grade students are charged an 8th grade promotion fee of \$50. This fee will be added to the scheduled February tuition payment through FACTS for current 8th grade students.

GRANDPARENTS DAY 2017: Grandparents and great-grandparents of all CHS students are invited to the 2017 Grandparents Day celebration on Sunday, March 19, 2017 from 2-4 p.m., in the CHS Gymnasium. Please note, students are invited and urged to attend with their grandparents. Students will be able to sit with their grandparents during the program in the gymnasium.

More than 900 guests gathered last year, and it is my hope that attendance this year will be just as large. It is a wonderful opportunity for students to spend a few hours with their grandparents and tour the CHS campus. The CHS Mothers' Club will host a reception for the guests after the program. The CHS Photography Club will be available to take memento photos.

JOB SHADOWING CALENDAR 2017

All seniors **MUST** participate in Job Shadowing. You are required to turn in a Job Shadowing Plan to the Counseling Center in February.

On Job Shadowing Day, you should spend six (6) hours shadowing a professional (mentor) in a career that is of interest to you. The professional must be a college graduate and cannot be your parent(s). No more than 2 students can shadow together with the same mentor at the same site.

You should leave the enclosed evaluation form with your mentor. Ask him/her to complete the form and mail it back to CHS in the self-addressed, stamped envelope.

When you return to school, you will be asked to complete a reflection exercise within one week of Job Shadowing Day. This will be turned in to your English IV teacher.

Here is your Job Shadowing Timeline:

Week of January 16, 2017	Job Shadowing information given to all seniors
Friday, February 24, 2017	Deadline to turn in your completed and signed <u>Job Shadowing Plan</u> to the Counseling Center. This is a <u>FIRM</u> deadline; no exceptions!
Monday, March 13, 2017	Contact your mentor to confirm your arrangements for Job Shadowing Day.
Monday, March 20, 2017	<u>JOB SHADOWING DAY</u> : Spend a <u>MINIMUM</u> of six (6) hours in job shadowing. Be sure to leave the evaluation form with your mentor.
Monday, March 27, 2017	Reflection exercise is due to your English IV teacher.

As part of our continuing effort to prepare students to succeed on standardized tests, Catholic High will offer a special preparation program for the Preliminary Scholastic Assessment Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (**PSAT/NMSQT**). It is through this test that students compete for the honor of being recognized as **National Merit Semifinalist** or a National Merit Commended Student. This test is also the vehicle through which qualified students earn the opportunity to compete for National Merit Scholarships.

Mrs. Christy Kessler will be the workshop presenter. The workshop will include six sessions:

- Saturday, March 18 from 9 a.m. to noon
- Saturday, April 29 from 9 a.m. to noon
- Saturday, May 13 from 9 a.m. to noon
