March 9 and March 15: Special schedule for standardized test preparation for 9th-11th grades and presentations for 8th and 12th grade students. Dismissal at 2:47 p.m.

OFFICE HOURS: Offices will be open during the week of the Mardi Gras break Thursday, March 2 and Friday, March 3 from 8 a.m. until 2 p.m..

MARCH 21 DETAILS: This is a required day of school for all Catholic High students. The following are details for each grade level. Breakfast will be available in the Union before school and snacks will be available after testing.

8th Grade Students: All 8th grade students will participate in their mandatory retreat. The retreat will be held at the Catholic Life Center's Bishop Tracy Center at 1800 South Acadian Thruway. Parents must provide transportation to and from the retreat. Students can be dropped off beginning at 7:30 a.m. and the retreat will

begin promptly at 8 a.m. Lunch will be provided. The retreat ends at 2:45 p.m. and students should be picked up at that time.

9th Grade Students: Practice PSAT Testing. All students must be in their designated classrooms by 8:00 a.m. The approximate end time for testing is 11:30 a.m.

10th and 11th Grade Students: ACT testing. All students must be in their designated classrooms by 8:00 a.m. The approximate end time for testing is 11:30 a.m.

12th Grade Students: Field trip to WWII Museum in New Orleans. This is a mandatory school day for all seniors. The buses will depart Catholic High School at 7:00 a.m. **It is imperative that all seniors be at school by 6:45 so that the buses can load for a 7:00 a.m. departure.** Arrival back at Catholic High will be at approximately 3:00 p.m. Lunch is provided. Seniors must wear standard school attire.

12TH GRADE STUDENTS ATTENDING THE WWII MUSEUM FIELD TRIP: CHS will charge the family FACTS account of each 12th grade student \$50 on April 1 for the cost of the WWII field trip on March 21. This includes the costs for the charter bus, admission into the museum, and lunch.

REMINDER – CAR RAFFLE TICKETS: In November, all students received a packet of car raffle tickets for each family to sell. All tickets must be returned to Catholic High School, even if they are unsold. There is a box in the main lobby of school where students can turn in the tickets. Please consider selling or buying the tickets and have your son return them to school. The drawing for the car will take place at the Lip Sync Battle on March 11. Each student who turns in a packet of sold tickets will have his name go in a weekly drawing for a gift certificate.

Trip](#) . A parent and student informational meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 21, at 7:00 p.m. in the SJA Activity Center. This meeting is not mandatory, but it is the only meeting for CHS parents. This is a great trip and I encourage you to consider this opportunity for your son to see our nation's capital.

SCHEDULING 2017-2018: Scheduling for the 2017-2018 school year began at the end of January when students requested courses online. During the week of March 13 course requests will be available in your PlusPortals E-Locker. We consider course selection to be a serious decision by students and parents so we ask all students and parents to review their course selections and discuss whether there are any changes you would like to make. Changes to course requests must be returned to the assistant principals' office by Thursday, March 23. Instructions about making changes can be found on the course selection sheet. Final deadlines for course selection will take place in April and will be considered a commitment on the part of students. You may contact your son's guidance counselor or Jared Cavalier if you need further information.

END OF THE THIRD QUARTER: The third quarter of our school year will end on Friday, March 10. Your son's third-quarter grades will be based on a combination of daily work, projects, tests and quizzes given during the quarter. Report cards will be in the E-Locker section of PlusPortals by Friday, March 17.

DEADLINE FOR REQUESTS FOR TUITION

ASSISTANCE [From Gerald Tullier]: Applications for tuition assistance for the 2017-2018 school year must be submitted by Tuesday, April 18, 2017. Note that applications must be submitted by all persons who are requesting tuition assistance, both those applying for the first time and those who received tuition assistance during the 2016-2017 school year and are re-applying for tuition assistance for the coming school year.

Applications for assistance are to be submitted on-line through FACTS. A link to the FACTS web page can be found in the "Tuition Assistance" section of the CHS web page. You will need to create a FACTS account and log-in, and then complete the application online.

In keeping with the educational tradition of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart, **no student is refused admission or asked to leave Catholic High School solely because of his family's inability to pay tuition.** Tuition assistance is available for students whose families are unable to pay the full cost of tuition.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS ABOUT CARPOOL PICKUP:

Dr. Eldringhoff reminded students before the Mardi Gras break about acceptable areas for carpool drop-off and pick-up. Of course we need your assistance in adhering to our policies.

- If you pick up your son from school in the afternoon, please wait until after 3 p.m. to pick him up. Delaying your arrival allows much of the traffic leaving school to clear the neighborhood and it also avoids a long line of cars stretching down Claycut towards Acadian Thruway.
- Students cannot be dropped off or picked up in the senior parking lot or in Westmoreland until after 4:00 p.m. This is a safety issue.
- Students cannot be dropped off or picked up on the street or the shoulder along Claycut. Again, this is a serious safety concern for our students.
- Students waiting for rides in the Hearthstone circle after 4:00 p.m. must wait inside the school.

Faculty proctors in the parking lots will talk to students who violate our policies concerning drop-off and pick-up and may give consequences for not following our expectations. Our first concern is always safety for our students and we ask your assistance in making sure that all students are protected.

We appreciate any help you can give us in minimizing traffic congestion during peak carpool times. It is a constant challenge to CHS to protect the safety of our students and simultaneously be a good neighbor to the residents in our neighborhood. Thank you.

- \$11,040.00 for seniors (includes graduation and retreat fees)

#2 Semi-Annual Payments—due on July 1, 2017 and December 1, 2017

- \$5,520.00 for returning underclassmen (includes re-registration fee for 2018-2019)
- \$5,520.00 for seniors (includes graduation and retreat fees)

#3 Monthly Installment Payments through FACTS—see below for details.

Note: All tuition payments will be made on-line through FACTS. There is no FACTS charge for annual payments. However, FACTS will charge a \$45 annual fee for the Monthly Installment Plan and a \$10 annual fee for the Semi-Annual Installment Plan.

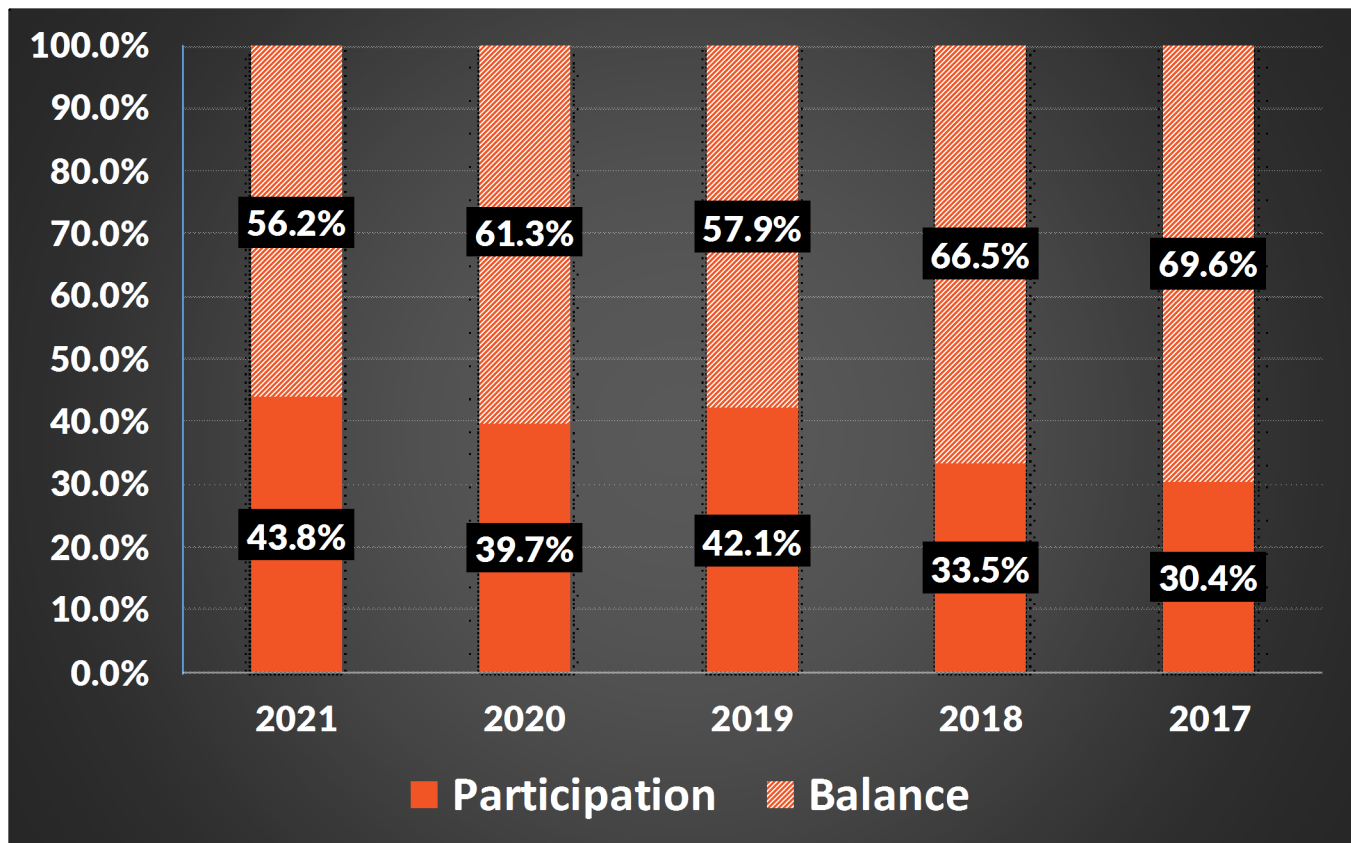
